Participants are responsible for their own reservation and payment. However, we have arranged for a block of rooms at Delta Baltimore Hunt Valley Hotel. If you have not reserved, please do so as soon as possible.

Hotel rooms cost \$159.00 per night under the NCBI group rate. When making your reservation, simply mention you are part of the NCBI conference to receive this exclusive rate.

**IMPORTANT:** Please reserve your room on or by **July 21, 2018** to receive the reduced rate. Please specify whether you want a room with two double beds or one king bed when you make your reservation with the hotel.

Travel to/from the Hotel:

Airport or train station transportation is available through Light Rail, private car, taxi or Super Shuttle.

There are 33 Light Rail station stops along the system. The Light Rail is a 'barrier-free' system, so tickets are purchased from the ticket vending machine before boarding.

Tickets are not available on board. Trains run daily. For more information, visit Maryland Transit Administration or call 800-325-7245. The hotel provides free shuttle service to the light rail station on week-days.

Additionally, guests may inquire about pricing and availability for transport in the hotel's luxury SUV to and from BWI Airport and Baltimore's Inner Harbor area. For information, contact the front desk at 410-785-7000.

*From Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA) – 61 miles; 1 hour 8 minutes*

Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport is served by Air Canada, AirTran, Alaska Airlines, American Airlines, Delta, Frontier Airlines, JetBlue, Southwest Airlines, Sun Country Airlines, United Airlines, US Airways and Virgin America. Rental cars are available at the airport.

*From Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD) – 78 miles; 1 hour 21 minutes*
