Closest Airports

The closest airport to the training site is Thurgood Marshall Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI). We recommend that all training participants fly into BWI.

The Hunt Valley, Maryland area is served by three airports. The distance from each airport to the hotel is as follows:

- · From Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI) 30.68 miles; 32 minutes
- From Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA) 61 miles; 1 hour 8 minutes
- From Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD) 78 miles; 1 hour 21 minutes

Travel to/from the Hotel:

Airport or train station transportation is available through Light Rail, private car, taxi or Super Shuttle.

There are 33 Light Rail station stops along the system. The Light Rail is a 'barrier-free' system, so tickets are purchased from the ticket vending machine before boarding. Tickets are not available on board. Trains run daily. For more information, visit Maryland Transit Administration or call 800-325-7245.

Embassy Suites provides a complimentary shuttle (7am - 10:30pm) within a 5-mile radius of the hotel; this includes the closest light rail station located at 98 Shawan Road. Hunt Valley, MD 21031. A 30-minute notice is required.

<u>Meals</u>

A free lunch is included in the price of registration for all participants. Breakfast is available to NCBI Institute participants who stay at the hotel. Other meals are easily obtained in the hotel restaurant or neighboring eating establishments.

<u>Culture Share</u>: One of the highlights of our Institute is culture sharing. Participants will have an opportunity to share something from their cultural background. We invite you to come with a song, poem, story, dance, pictures, or anything that you would like to share about your heritage. Our experience has been that certain people think of themselves as having a culture; others have difficulty thinking of their background. Wherever you and your ancestors come from, or whatever your family is like, your background is rich with culture. Think about what makes you, your family, and your people distinctive. You are warmly invited to share that.

Many of you may have participated in conferences where you can easily come and go; because of the nature of this work, attending each session is important for the continuity of the Institute. We build a community within the Institute and periodically break into small groups for leadership practice. At all the Institute sessions, your presence makes a big difference. We know that Baltimore is an interesting place to visit, but please arrange any sightseeing before or after the Institute. If you know that you are going to miss a session, please let us know ahead of time.
